Its mission is to protect and restore wild salmon ecosystems in the Hood Canal Watershed through restoration, research, education and stewardship. The Knotweed Control and Riparian Enhancement Project is targeted at 8 watersheds throughout the Hood Canal region. We are working to control knotweed and replace it with native riparian vegetation. The noxious weed landowner outreach intern will be working with staff to increase landowner participation in HCSEG's Riparian Enhancement project.
